ONE TRUCKEE RIVER COORDINATOR TEAM

One Truckee River has a new coordinator team to help the OTR partnership further advance the goals of the One Truckee River Management Plan adopted by Washoe County, Sparks, and Reno in 2016. Iris Jehle-Peppard and Alex Hoeft have been brought on as One Truckee River Coordinator and One Truckee River Associate Coordinator, respectively.

Jehle-Peppard, an independent contractor, recently returned to Reno after 14 years in Monterey Bay, Calif. as Executive Director at Everyone's Harvest, a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing healthy food access to working-class communities. "I'm very excited about working with One Truckee River," Jehle-Peppard said. "I'm inspired by the initiative's combination of sustainability and community efforts — there's great opportunity for truly significant success!"


Hoeft began working with OTR in May 2015 as an AmeriCorps member, before moving up to manage all communications and outreach for the initiative. "We're ready to take OTR to the next level, starting with May's first ever One Truckee River Month, as well as implementation of the management plan's next set of priorities," Hoeft explained.

Among other tasks, Jehle-Peppard and Hoeft will connect regularly with the region's elected officials and other key OTR stakeholders, coordinate partnership meetings and public engagement, identify project development and funding opportunities, and serve as leads on specific action items as determined by the OTR Partnership Council. The Truckee River Fund at the Community Foundation of Western Nevada has provided the majority of funding for the new positions. Additional support has come from Nevada Division of Environmental Protection and an anonymous private donor.
