

Photo Contest Terms and Rules

1. Terms and Conditions
 - a. Runs from March 1 to April 1, 2019
 - b. **By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees to the Official Rules and warrants that his or her entry complies with all requirements set out in the Official Rules.** This is a skill-based contest and chance plays no part in the determination of winners.
 - c. Entries are void if One Truckee River (OTR) determines the photograph to not be an original, or if the entries are incomplete, inaccessible or blocked, corrupted, damaged, irregular, altered, counterfeit, produced in error or obtained through fraud or theft.
 - d. The contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law.
2. Who May Enter
 - a. All individuals, excluding employees and family members of OTR and judges
3. How to Enter
 - a. Website link
 - b. Entry form for each photograph
 - i. name, telephone number, email address, file upload, date and photo location
4. What to Enter
 - a. Photo must include the Truckee River or one of its tributaries
 - b. One entry per person
 - c. May only submit photo once to one of the categories
 - d. Categories
 - i. People - shows people interacting with the river
 - ii. Landscape - nature or landscapes without people
 - iii. Mobile Device - taken with a phone or tablet camera
 - iv. Youth Category - 17 and under
 - e. Digital Format
 - i. The photograph need not be taken with a digital camera, but they must be submitted digitally; scans of negatives, transparencies, or photographic prints are acceptable
 - ii. JPEG format
 - iii. Minimum 300 dpi
 - iv. Online Submission File Size: Max 5 MB (Please note that larger files may be required for printing winning entries. Entrants are advised to keep copies of their original files before downsizing for upload to the website.)
 - v. For purposes of printing, we recommend using a 4:3 aspect ratio
 - f. Photos must have been taken within the calendar year prior to submission
 - g. Only minor burning, dodging and/or color correction is acceptable, as is minor cropping. High dynamic range images (HDR) and stitched panoramas are acceptable.
